WXLV 30-SECOND DIGITAL PSA SCRIPT, 1/1-2/17/09:

"NOTICE HOW DIGITAL'S MADE PRETTY MUCH EVERYTHING BETTER, ESPECIALLY TELEVISION? DIGITAL TV'S GOT BETTER PICTURE, BETTER SOUND ,MORE CHANNELS -- IN FACT, DIGITAL'S SO MUCH BETTER THAT, BY LAW, ALL BROADCAST TV HAS TO BE DIGITAL BY 2009. WXLV ABC 45 PROGRAMMING IS NOW OVER-THE-AIR ON DIGITAL CHANNEL 45.1 AND CAN BE RECEIVED WITH THE USE OF A DIGITAL TV OR WITH A CONVERTER BOX AND AN ANTENNA OR VIA CABLE OR SATELLITE. "AN IMPORTANT MESSAGE FROM WXLV-TV, ABC45: FULL POWER ANALOG TV BROADCASTS WILL END ON 2/17/09 AND ANALOG-ONLY TELEVISIONS MAY LOSE SIGNAL BEING VIEWED UNLESS VIEWER TAKES ACTION. OVER-THE-AIR VIEWING ON ANALOG-ONLY TELEVISIONS WILL REQUIRE THE USE OF A CONVERTER BOX. WXLV CRAWL TEXT 2/11-2/17 ONLY: "WXLV-TV ABC45, LICENSED TO WINSTON-SALEM, NORTH CAROLINA, WILL BE TERMINATING IT'S ANALOG OPERATIONS AT 11:59PM ON FEBRUARY 17, 2009, WHICH IS EARLIER THAN THE NEW NATIONAL TRANSITION DATE OF JUNE 12, 2009, FOR ALL BROADCAST STATIONS TO CEASE ANALOG OPERATIONS. VIEWERS WHO ARE SUBSCRIBERS TO A SERVICE SUCH AS CABLE OR SATELLITE WILL NOT BE AFFECTED BY THIS CHANGE.
